



HONORARY PRESIDENT APPOINTMENT POLICY

1. Overview

- 1.1 The purpose of this policy is to set out procedures to be followed in order to implement Club Rule 10.1 which says that the Club Committee may from time to time appoint a Club President or a Club Vice President.
- 1.2 The honorary positions of Club President and Club Vice President are made to recognise significant contributions made to the Club. These positions are ceremonial and may involve activities such as awarding trophies at tournaments.
- 1.3 For the avoidance of doubt, holders of these positions will continue to pay their Club membership subscriptions as per normal.

2. Tenure

- 2.1 Club Rule 10.3 says that the tenure of Club President is one year and once a member has served as Club President he or she is not eligible for future appointment as Club President or Vice President. The tenure of Club Vice President is one year immediately following which the Club Vice President shall become Club President. Or in the absence of a Vice President a new Club President may be appointed.

3. Nomination Committee

- 3.1 Each year the Club Chair together with the Club Vice Chair, the Chair of Tennis and the Chair of Croquet will meet to consider

members who they believe have made a significant contribution to the Club.

- 3.2 They will then make a proposal to the Club Committee as regards the appointment of next Vice President, or if there is no incumbent Vice President the next President.
- 3.3 Consistent with Club Rule 10.4, the incumbent Club Chair, Vice Chair, Tennis Chair, and Croquet Chair are excluded as candidates for the Vice President and President positions to be proposed for consideration by the Club Committee.
- 3.4 The decision of the Club Committee will then be communicated to the members by the Club Chair.
