



ART DISPLAY POLICY

1. Support for the Arts

Many members of our Club have artistic talents. To support the arts the Club has decided to make the Clubhouse of Old College available to serve as an exhibition space for artistic works of the club's membership.

2. Submission of Works of Art

All members are very welcome to submit works of art. If you would like to display a work of art then please submit digital images of the work to a member of the Art Committee, whose names are listed on the Club's website.

3. Selection Process

Art to display will be chosen on the basis of randomised, fair and equal access selection process.

4. Art for Sale

The works can be displayed for sale. For would be purchasers, the price-list will be available behind the bar. It is up to the purchaser to contact the artist about any works they wish to purchase. Those wishing to submit works need to provide the titles of their various pieces, the prices where applicable and any specific hanging requirements.

5. Display of Art

There is space for approximately a maximum of seven works at A3-A2 size, in the bar area and the main-hall. The works, where necessary, will need to be framed by the artist. The hanging of art will be taken care of by the Art Committee of the Club. The Art Committee will try to cluster pictures that work well together.

6. Duration of the Exhibition

The duration of any exhibition will typically extend over a period of 4 weeks.

7. Artists own Risk

The club can accept no responsibility for any damage, loss or theft that may occur to any exhibited works.
